## **Dorado Stars Prospect program policies**

### **1. Make-up Lesson Policy**

In the event that the Dorado Stars cancels a lesson for reasons such as, pool closing, competition schedule, holidays, etc... a make-up class will be offered to all families who were affected by the cancellation . A schedule of available dates for a make-up lesson will be issued by the Team Manager. Make-up lessons are not offered under any other circumstances.

### **2. Fins Policy**

Please note that **all children participating in the Prospects program must have their own pair of fins**. We recommend that each child have their names on the fins. You may use a permanent marker. The entire curriculum is designed around the use of fins as it allows the children to develop skills more rapidly and comfortably. Children who do not have fins will not be permitted to swim.

### **3. Communication Policy**

All questions pertaining to registration, make-up classes, try-outs and any other logistical matters are to be directed to Team Manager, Carmen Desjardins. Any questions specifically related to the class curriculum are to be directed to the coaching staff. Please refrain from attempting to communicate with the coaches during class time, as this creates a distraction for the entire class. All coaches will be available in person for discussion after the workout. At that time, they will be more than happy to answer any of your questions. Note that all group up-dates are done via email. Your registration form must include a working email address, print it clearly and be sure to check it regularly.

### **4. Swim Apparel**

It is recommended that girls wear a one piece polyester suit bathing cap & goggles It is recommended that boys wear a polyester jammer suit & goggles. Bathing suits and fins may be purchased at Swim and Sports.

## 6. **Refund policy**

Notice **must** be given in writing no later than two weeks following the program start date. The balance of the session, which equals 8 weeks, would qualify for a pro-rated refund. Administration fee + Swim Ontario Fee to be noted as non-refundable.

### **Exception:**

A pro-rated refund would be issued beyond this timeline, **only** if accompanied by a doctor's note. Refund issued at the discretion of the Board, if a member cancels their registration for reasons other than those mentioned above. This to include circumstances beyond one's control.

### **Winter and Spring session refund policy**

#### **Returning members**

If one wishes to terminate their member registration to either the Winter and or Spring sessions, notice of program withdrawal must be given in writing to the Team Manager and Coach no less than one week prior to the beginning of the above mentioned sessions.

#### **First time registrations**

Notice to be given in writing no later than two weeks following the program start date. The balance of the session, which would equal 8 weeks, would qualify for a pro-rated refund. Administration fee + Swim Ontario Fee to be noted as non-refundable.

### **Exception:**

A pro-rated refund would be issued beyond this timeline, only if accompanied by a doctor's note. Refund issued at the discretion of the Board, if a member cancels their registration for reasons other than those mentioned above. This to include circumstances beyond one's control.
