The wheel of success starts turning for Dorado swimmers.

After an average meet in Caledon, the Dorado Stars Swim Club was heading to Vaughan for the last swim meet before the Christmas holiday. A total of 37 swimmers took part in the three-day meet. "I remember in 2010, at the same meet, having to wait during the afternoon session because we had no young swimmers ready to compete. This year, I've been really busy with no less than ten swimmers aged of 10 and under competing at the meet. This is the best proof we have to confirm that our development has been successful over the last months" said Head Coach Pierre-Étienne Lambert.

An impressive total of 40 new standards have been attained during the week-end by the Caledon swimmers. "This is from far my best competition as the club Head Coach. It was just amazing to see our swimmers diving off the blocks with such a desire to reach another level. The kids are developing their desire for fast

swimming and slowly the wheel of success starts turning" added Lambert.

More than those new standards, Dorado also qualified two swimmers for the Central Region



Championship in February. Ashley Riddall (50m freestyle) and Chloe Noguera (100m freestyle) will join Samantha Hillson (already qualified) for this important competition. "We still

have two more meets before February and we have 4 more potential swimmers able to qualify for this Championship: Harsimrat Dhaliwal, Kira Eggen-goor, Amy Karpenko and Jessie Ye have a good chance to get their tickets.

On an individual point of view, Vaughan has been really good for other swimmers who realized great personal performances. Ashley Riddall and Jessie Ye both won the 50m freestyle event with a tie. Ye also established no less than 8 new standards. 10 year old Christian Nagy won the 50m breaststroke. Alicia Lubja and Kaitlyn Haller completed the competition with 1 podium each while Nicole Nagy and Samantha Hillson completed with 2.

Dorado swimmers will enjoy a couple of days off before Christmas and will be back in the pool on December 27th to prepare another important competition in Markham.

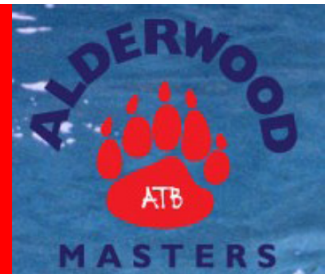
